FIFA Financial Assistance Programme (FAP) 1999 - 2002

Dear Sir,

We refer to your letter dated 2 January 2003 and to the recent telephone conversation concerning the joint memorandum between FIFA and the Antigua/Barbuda FA (ABFA) regarding the management of the FIFA FAP contribution to your association.

On 26 July 2000 the ABFA together with FIFA and Mr. Jack A. Warner, CONCACAF President and FIFA Vice-President, jointly agreed on a plan to remedy the liquidity situation of the ABFA. Based on these discussions, a new bank account was opened and C.A.S. Hewlett & Co. was mandated by FIFA to manage and control all FAP payments the ABFA received from FIFA until the end of 2002.

Mr Raymond L. Doorgen, a partner at C.A.S. Hewlett & Co., has submitted regular quarterly statements in accordance with the above memorandum. We expect to receive the statement for the last quarter of 2002 together with the final report for July 2000 - 2002 in the coming weeks.

We are happy that the procedures described in the memorandum have helped meet our joint objective of stabilising the financial situation of the ABFA. We are also satisfied that from 2003 onwards the ABFA will itself manage the use of FIFA FAP funds in accordance with the applicable regulations.

We are pleased to enclose a copy of the joint memorandum.

We appreciate the collaboration of ABFA in recent years and look forward to a continued successful relationship with you to promote the development of football in Antigua & Barbuda.
